B TTC Club Rules and Code of Conduct

- **FEES:** Membership fees must be paid at the start of the semester. Exceptions need prior approval of the Club President. Membership is not transferable.
- **EQUIPMENT & FACILITY:** Players will be held responsible if they damage any equipment belonging to the Club. Players are not to lean on, sit on or strike the tables. Purposeful damage to the Club's equipment may result in expulsion and loss of membership. Smoking, gambling, weapons, alcohol is strictly not permitted in the club facility. No food or drinks are permitted in the playing areas. All players are expected to clear up their personal belongings/trash from the playing area after a session.

If you get to the club early, please help bring out the tables. If you can't stay late, please assist with the setup of several tables. Everyone is expected to assist in putting away the tables at the end of their play. Please see a board member before putting any tables away. In order to avoid damage to the nets, they need to be rolled up properly. Ask a club officer if you need guidance. The club is for all of us, so please treat it respectfully.

- **BEHAVIOR:** All players must conduct themselves in a sportsman-like manner. Loud or offensive language will not be tolerated. Players are expected to be courteous and polite. It is customary to shake hands or do a high/low five after a game. More proficient players are expected to help and encourage newcomers to enjoy, understand, and better play the sport of table tennis. Players should have the courtesy of helping to pick up stray balls and returning them to ball containers.
- **Building SECURITY:** The Superintendent of the Connetquot School District, and the Town of Islip, has instituted security protocols for the building and grounds. As a result of this change, we are required to keep all outside doors closed at all times. Please use the main door entrance to enter and to exit.
- **TOWN OF ISLIP:** All members are required to follow all rules and regulations implemented at the Brentwood Recreation Center by the Town of Islip.
- **ENFORCEMENT:** The Club has the right to reserve/assign certain number of tables for Training, Coaching, Club tournament or special events. The Club President and officers are authorized to enforce the Club rules and code of conduct. Any violation gives the Club Officers the right to refuse service to the player or ask them to leave the facility immediately or suspend their membership. No refunds will be given to suspended players.
- **CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS:** The Club has a 'No Refund' policy for all the memberships
- **PHOTOGRAPHS AND VIDEO RECORDINGS:** BTTC Staff may take photographs or video recordings at BTTC functions for use in Club publicity. This includes but is not limited to: BTTC's Facebook page, BTTC's website, YouTube channel, and digital signage. Please inform us if you do not want photos taken of you or your children. - **Family Club:** The BTTC prides itself on being a place to help families have fun and bond together. With this being said, we have a policy that requires all children under the age of 16, to have an adult family member present at all times.
